Essentials of Fire Chaplaincy (Basic Level 100)

The Essentials of Fire Chaplaincy is a 16 hour course introduced to the fire chaplaincy. The Essentials of Fire Chaplaincy is the basic level 100 course of fire chaplains, a foundational study upon which all other chaplaincy courses are built. The Essentials class is designed to train newly appointed fire chaplains, as well as veteran chaplains who need a refresher course to update their information and skills.

Program Highlights

- An introduction, foundation and history of the fire chaplaincy and history of the Federation of Fire Chaplains
- The Personhood of the chaplain (Who you are as a fire chaplain)
- The fire chaplains ministry to the firefighter (What you do as a fire chaplain)
- How to begin a fire chaplaincy program (How to develop your fire chaplaincy program)
- Chaplaincy Operations on the emergency scene (How you operate as a chaplain on the scene)
- The chaplain's ministry to crisis victims (How you do and don't do with crisis victims)
- Introduction to Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) (Only an overview)
- Firefighter injury and death notification (How to do and not to do on this important subject)
- An introduction to Fire Department Funeral procedures. (Walk-through a FD Funeral)
- HIPAA, Confidentiality, PSOB and EPA (Important things a fire chaplain need to know)

This 16 hour (two-day) class is the basic foundational component of your advanced training in fire chaplaincy. After completion of the Essentials class, you are encouraged toward an Advanced Chaplaincy Certificate by completing 130+ hours of training and experience in fire chaplaincy.

The next step after the Essentials class is to complete the <u>Application for the FFC Institute</u> and enroll in the FFC. Initial FFC dues are \$125.00 includes your enrollment in the Institute which sets up and tracks your training and experience. FFC dues are \$100 a year thereafter.
